5. Review Action Item(s)



6. **Fundraisers**

Perogy, Sausage & Meat Bun Fundraiser

- i. I will let Sebastien discuss the financials for this event
 - We made approximately 4k from the fundraiser. We have not yet received a cheque from The Country Perogy Shop. It will be over 1,700\$, totalling close to 6,000\$!
- ii. Pickup is tomorrow This year is the first year that all volunteer positions were filled and not only were they filled, they were filled on the first day the email went out specifically requesting volunteers for this event.
- iii. We will need to purchase bags for next year. After some research I have found 3 viable options:

FundScrip Gift Card Fundraiser

i. Just as I was preparing to go live with the fundraiser, I was told by FundScrip that we need to go with the dates within their table and as such, the dates had to change from Nov.1 - Dec.4 to Nov.1 - Nov.22. This also impacts our pickup dates from being Dec.12 & 16 to Dec. 5 & 10. I think these pickup dates are much better because people will have their order sooner. One supporter advised that the pickup dates were still too late for his employee Christmas gifts, advising that a pickup at the end of November would have been ideal.

- ii. Order form was updated & flier created. Additionally, Cayla has created an ad for social media which is live. Website is live with details & the order form.
- iii. As of 2024/10/11 we have received:
 - 8 orders
 - \$3,870.00 in orders
 - \$117.93 in profit
- iv. Orders over \$3000 pay half of the delivery costs and orders over \$5000 pay no delivery costs. I am confident we'll make it over \$5000
- v. We have learned that purchases cannot be made on a phone and must be done on a computer, unfortunately.

8. **Grade Rep Activity Update**

- <u>Grade 6:</u> Reps, Linsy Gariepy; Dorothea Osborne; Rosemarie Mauer. They sent out a survey to determine the best date for the event and have now planned their event for November 23rd at FunPark.
- Grade 7: Rep, Susan Loewen, held their event at Activate on October 25th.
 She said the venue was great and that people had a great time. 29 families registered with a total of 74 attendees.
- Grade 8: Reps, Rachel Laurendeau; Nina Kandera; Trisha Klassen; Zilla Jones, holding their event at Across the Board on November 24th.
 - *Across the Board requires a \$500 deposit so the PA has committed to contribute \$100 towards this fee, with the rest being divided equally among the attending families. If they get over 55 people, then the deposit is waived.
- Grade 9: Reps, Allison Pollard; Carolyn Minor, held their event at A Maze in Corn on October 27th. Carolyn said, "They had a beautiful day, the venue was great and people enjoyed their time there." 20 families registered with a total of 65 attendees.
- Grade 10: Reps, Angela Kornelsen; Olga Lytvynenko, have started planning their event for November 30th at Uptown Alley. I'm waiting on details of the event so that a registration form and emails/announcements can be created.
- <u>Grade 11:</u> Reps, Jennifer Goreski; Jennifer Lewis, held their event at Uptown
 Alley on November 8th. 23 families registered with a total of 51 attendees.

Jennifer Lewis said, "We were also able to reserve the back section of the restaurant area for parents to visit. It was slightly quieter there, and we were able to order drinks and food. We had two tables full of parents chatting. Overall, it was a successful evening. My son actually asked me if we could plan a second grade event later in the year."

 Grade 12: Mardina Andrews; Zilla Jones; Anna Swaine; Anna Randall-Gryz, have planned their event for November 27th. It is a Food, Trivia & Fun night, similar to what they planned for grade 11 last year and which was well received.

Details of Request: In tightening up our cell phone policy to be in line with Manitoba Education, some of our previous methods of instruction have become more difficult. In French and German classes, teachers will often provide opportunities for students to listen to real German or French speakers and complete connecting activities. Our language classrooms have a diversity of levels and so students aren't always watching the same videos. Having headphones allows our teachers to meet the students at their unique level. Some of our other teachers have also expressed interest so that kids can play music from their chromebooks while working on a quiet assignment. Some of our students have headphones, some have earbuds, some don't have any. Some of our chromebooks allow for bluetooth connection and some don't. We would like to purchase a number of headphones so that teachers can sign them out for a class and 2 stands to help keep them organized as they may move from room to room.

Options & Pricing: We want to balance cost and durability. We found these in a catalog for schools, so they aren't too cheap, but the price is still incredible.
